## GOD'S WORD – OUR MANUAL AND MANNA

There is only ONE way to obtain eternal life – I John 5:11-12. Salvation is just the beginning. It is our responsibility to not only live by the Word, but to pass the truths of God's Word on to our children "Diligently". Deuteronomy 6:6-7 Carelessness in the Word of God not only effects our lives, but by it we can be gambling with the eternal well being of our children and grandchildren.

## I. What kind of Bible should I have?

- A. The most reliable translation. Although there are two or three good scholarly English translations of the Bible, our church has always used the King James translation because it is so true to the original languages. Just because another translation seems to make the Bible more understandable does not mean that it is true to the Hebrew and Greek text.
- B. Modern translations that are based on concept inspiration. If the Bible is concept inspired, then this gives license to change the wording of the concepts or ideas. If the Bible is verbally and plenarily inspired, in the original languages then to tamper with a single word spells disaster. ("Plenarily" means it is equally inspired in all of its parts.)
- C. There may be minor variations in the few reliable English translations. This is simply because no word-for-word translation can be made from one language to another.
- D. Beware of alterations that effect:
  - 1. Deity of Christ
  - 2. Virgin Birth
  - 3. Miracles
  - 4. Blood Atonement
  - 5. Changes in maps
- E. The advantages of everyone using the same translation:
  - 1. The use of several translations causes confusion.
  - 2. It causes questions as to which translation is correct.
  - 3. People often get discouraged and stop bringing their Bible to church.
  - 4. It also causes doubts in people's minds as to whether or not we have the very word of God.
